**Functional Description:**

The Senior Designer is responsible for both the overall game concept and the detailed elements of the game design.

Oversee all elements of gameplay, story, characters, level design and scripts  
Collaborate with the design, art and technical teams to implement and iterate on the game vision  
Lead the design team to ship on time and with quality

Work closely with the technology and art leads to vet game requirements and dependencies  
Act as an expert resource on market competition and industry trends  
Keep abreast of and propose innovative design methods and processes  
Contribute to improved development processes

Keen interest in the casual gaming market  
A passion for understanding and serving the gaming preferences of the female audience
